Police

- 1) Working on pricing options for a replacement for our 2010 Charger police car. Council will be kept informed. Vehicle will be purchased from drug funds at no cost to the taxpayer.
- 2) Tires ordered for cruiser #4.
- 3) Would like to discuss with Police Committee some potential staffing changes to increase department efficiency.

Streets

- 1) We have basically finished a major pipe repair on the corner of College and Lee / Michigan. We replaced the current line with a larger line to alleviate neighborhood complaints. Total costs not to include manpower are approximately \$1,000.00. The timing was right to do this due to a break in the weather. Landscaping will be finished closer to spring and we also will make catch basin improvements as the weather allows.
- 2) We have also been patching as time and weather allow. I think it is going to be a bad year for potholes. Cold patch that is temporary is \$96.00 per ton.
- 3) Tires ordered for the Ranger. Even though it is a 1995 we can extend its use here.
- 4) Working on budget requests for the street department for 2018. They are relatively insignificant.
- 5) Street department called out at 5:00 A.M. the morning of 01-30-18 for snow removal. Were sent home after eight hours. No overtime.
