On February 18, 2018 at approximately 2108 hours, Ptl. Julie Henderson and Poland Village Officer Michael Koenig responded to an address on Diana Drive in regards to a possible drug overdose.

Upon arrival to the residence, forcible entry had to be made into the locked bathroom. Once inside, a male subject was observed face down on the floor. A syringe was in his hand, and he was unresponsive and cold to the touch.

The responding officers administered two doses of Naloxone Hydrochloride (commonly referred to as NARCAN), to the unresponsive male. A short time later he was revived, and upon him being transported to the hospital, was coherent and able to talk.

I have no doubt that this subject's life was saved due to the heroic actions displayed by these Officers.

I am nominating Poland Township Officer Julie L. Henderson, and Poland Village Officer Michael Koenig, to be honored for their exemplary actions. I am making this recommendation without reservation; in support of their prompt and unselfish act of rendering aid and assistance to a fellow citizen, which resulted in the saving of his life.
