Streets, Sidewalks, and Drainage Committee Minutes

A representative from the Poland Presbyterian Church presented an issue with a drain located within the Church parking lot. She was under the assumption, as were other members of the church, that this was a drain owned by the Village and was the Village's responsibility to maintain. Upon review, it was determined that the drain is not Village property but Commissioner Beatty will be bringing it up for discussion at the next Hine Committee meeting.

The Street department is splitting up days between grass cutting (afternoons) and patching (mornings).

Street Commissioner Beatty recommended Council approval to hire Louis Civarella as a part-time grass cutter for the Street Department.

Storm Sewer Work (Repair – Replace) projects are currently pending along College – Lee, College – Audubon, College – 10's Block – East Side, and 224 – west of Ohio Avenue.
