## Poland Village “Fun Fact”:

The Poland Municipal Forest was established by Village Council ordinance on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1938. “Poland Woods” is the first municipally owned forest in the state of Ohio.

## December Village Council Summary:

**General:** State Senator R-33 elect Michael Rulli, addressed council. The proposed 2019 budget for the Forest Board was approved by council. Aqua Ohio rates have been established via ordinance. Public comment regarding a proposed ordinance to avoid an excessive concentration of lawfully established and licensed group home facilities in the Village of Poland was heard and the first reading was tabled. Attorney Greg Hicks addressed council. A part time laborer/operator position has been established for the Street Department. A discussion about potential landlord registration was held. The Village has entered into the Mahoning County Hazard Mitigation Plan and the County Joint Communications Agreement.

**B.L.U.P.R.:** Despite the weather, the 2018 Lighting of the Village event was a great success. Gratitude was expressed to everyone involved. The Village Hall generator has been serviced.

**Finance, Wage, Audit, Insurance:** The committee has completed it’s work on a temporary budget for 2019.

**Legislation and Policy:** The committee will be working on re-writes to the historic preservation ordinance. It was noted that a meeting date still needs to be scheduled for January.

**Police Committee:** Chris Tripi has begun his training.

**Streets Committee:** The street department has been keeping up with snow fall and finishing leaf pick up. Early discussions have occurred about updating the Village’s sidewalk ordinance.

**Architectural Review Board:** A discussion was held on 7 Morse Place.

**Board of Zoning Appeals:** The board will be reviewing the Home Savings sign variance.

**Hine Memorial Fund:** The board has planted three new trees and has been discussing the potential construction of a retaining wall.

**Planning Commission:** The committee is reviewing a replat request and the historic preservation ordinance.

**Forest Board:** The board did not meet during the month of December due to holiday conflict.

**Records Commission:** No Report.

**W.R.J.F.D.:** The new ladder truck should be arriving in early January. A new compensation policy for the department has been approved for 2019. Training with the new ambulance has begun. The trustees are also considering options to restructure the board by 2020.
