November Village Council Summary:

General: A public session was held to discuss an ordinance preventing an excessive concentration of lawfully established and licensed group home facilities in the Village of Poland on November 6th. The Mayor inquired about joining the ABC Water District. Further research is being conducted on this matter. Notification was received from Eastgate indicating that funding should be in place for next year’s repaving project. A second public session was held regarding the proposed group home facility ordinance. State Representative elect Don Manning, R-59 addressed council. A \$5,000 check from Republic Services was presented to council to be used for parks and recreational expenses. A discussion was had about the potential dangers of the Yellow Creek water quality. It is advised that everyone refrain from entering the water under any circumstance.

B.L.U.P.R.: Preparations at Village Hall have been made for this year’s Lighting of the Village event. A discussion occurred about how the Republic Services donation would be spent.

Finance, Wage, Audit, Insurance: Required changes needed in the amended appropriations ordinance were discussed. It was noted that budget requests for 2019 should sent to the committee as soon as possible.

Legislation and Policy: The Solicitor edited some language in the upcoming historic preservation ordinance. The ordinance was then sent back to committee and planning commission for final review.

Police Committee: The hiring of Christopher Tripi as a part time patrolman was approved by council. Minor vehicle repairs and maintenance has been completed.

Streets Committee: Leaf pickup is progressing. Road salt has been delivered.

Architectural Review Board: Margaret Christopher has been selected as chairperson. Siding for a new roof at 95 W. McKinley Way, sign drawings for 202 S. Main St., an addition to 57 N. Main St., and projects at 106 Cover St. and Alverne are being considered.

Board of Zoning Appeals: A variance was granted on a fence request.

Hine Memorial Fund: Three new trees have been planted on the Hine property.

Planning Commission: Review of the historic preservation ordinance is ongoing.

Forest Board: Ongoing topics of discussion include; the damaged Butler Trail culvert, the Mauthe bridge, and the upcoming Enviroscience report.

Records Commission: No Report.

W.R.J.F.D.: The proposed Fire District levy has passed.
