Poland Village “Fun Fact”:

Poland strongly supported the Union Army during the beginnings of the Civil War. Due to the town’s immense patriotism and numerous volunteers, including eventual United States President, William McKinley, not a single draftee was required.

General: Village Council, Mayor, and Solicitor approved the hiring of MS Consultants to perform a study on the towers and bases of the Mauthe Bridge in the forest. A draft ordinance regarding group homes was distributed to members of Council. The Mayor attended an Eastgate Regional Council of Government meeting, which was a preliminary point meeting for the Village’s 2019 repaving project. A resolution was passed to honor Diane Ingold for her service with the Western Reserve Joint Fire District.

B.L.U.P.R.: The committee has submitted a number of bills for the “Lighting of the Village” event which have been processed. Using a donation from Republic Services to replant some trees on Village Property along Cortland Street was discussed, as well as a potential “McKinley Day” event.

Finance, Wage, Audit, Insurance: The Village Administrative Assistant’s change fund has been increased from \$50 to \$100.

Legislation and Policy: The committee reviewed both the group home and the historic preservation legislation.

Police Committee: Equipment for new cruiser has been delivered and installed. The new cruiser is now in service. The new employees are doing well. Firearm qualifications occurred on Tuesday, October 9th.

Streets Committee: The Street Department worked on a number of projects prior to the beginning to leaf pickup. The leaf machine was maintenance and is ready to go. Commencement of the 2018 Village repaving project was discussed.

Architectural Review Board: A sign permit application for 81 W. McKinley Way was approved. Outside sales at 50 E. McKinley Way were also discussed.

Board of Zoning Appeals: A special meeting was held on October 18th regarding a variance on a privacy fence.

Hine Memorial Fund: The Board is reviewing tree and retainer wall quotes. Their focus will be on planting.

Planning Commission: The draft historic preservation ordinance was reviewed. This has been an ongoing project for nearly a decade. The intent is to solidify this document by the end of the year.

Forest Board: The proposed budget for 2019 and the Mauthe Bridge status were discussed. The Butler Trail culvert is in bad shape and in need of repair. EnviroScience has been in the forest. Their report will hopefully be presented to the board by the end of the year.

Records Commission: No Report.

W.R.J.F.D.: The new command vehicle has arrived and is being prepped for use. The garage construction project is ongoing. A new 1 mill levy will be on the ballot to be used for an additional building and equipment in relation to backup ambulance services.
