Police

- 1) See attached Tyler George Letter. Again we run into issue of part-time employees maintaining more than 2 commissions and their availability.
- 2) No notable Police issues throughout the Celebrate Poland Festivities. Approximately 75 police hours expended.

Streets

- 1) A. Spoke to Gary Diorio of MS Consultants as advised by council. He said specifications are being put together and bids will be out in August.
B. Gary advised the Village did receive an Ohio Public Works Commission grant for paving in the amount of \$70,115.00. See attached paperwork.
C. Gary again advised that the evaluation of streets for paving is College (bottom), Hamilton, Island, Edgewater, Michigan and Venloe depending on bid costs. MS advised decisions were made by pavement quality and amount of traffic encountered, Venloe having the lowest traffic count.
- 2) Hine repairs completed or under way.
A. Roof replaced on Hine Garage
B. Damaged sidewalk removed, formed and awaiting concrete. Purchase order request submitted.
- 3) Spoke with David Griffith of ODOT in reference to US 224 paving project and traffic signal timing/phasing and the amount of crashes in the heavily travelled area. I have offered all traffic signal plans available and he advised he would send an intern to retrieve them, nothing as of yet. Interesting letter, please read.
